

Edgar H. Felix Bicycle Path

Ordinance No. 786, April 4, 1966, provided for the acquisition of that portion of the bed of the defunct Freehold and Jamesburg Agricultural Railroad lying within Manasquan Borough limits.

From this property, acquired from the Penndel Co., Delaware, at the cost of \$30,000, council created a bicycle path beginning at North Main Street and extending to the Wall township border.

The path was named in honor of Edgar H. Felix, a resident, who long had lobbied council for public use of the abandoned right-of-way.
